Tighten the four screws to a depth of 50%.

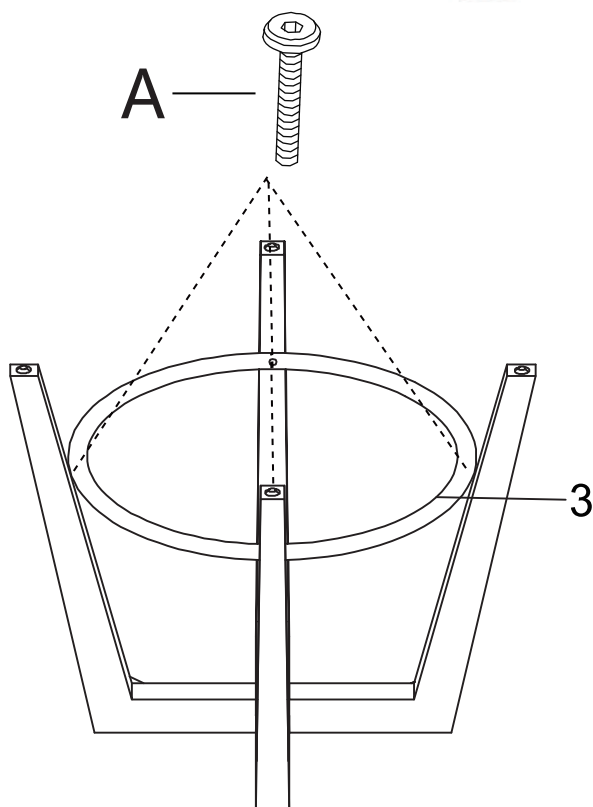
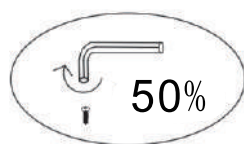

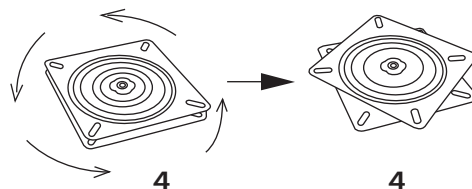
If the screw hole on the last leg cannot align with the hole, loosen the screws on the front three legs to adjust the distance.

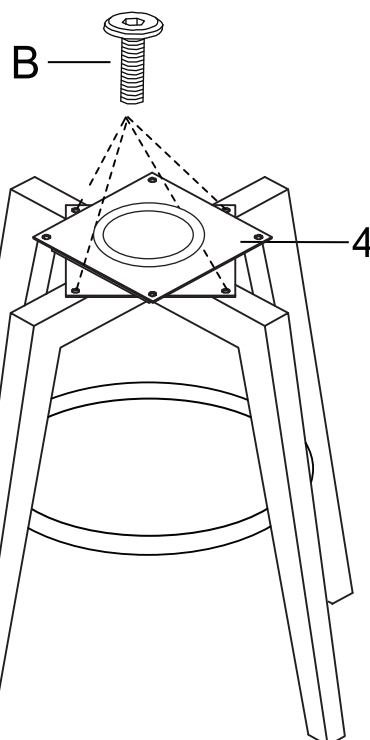
Tighten the four screws to a depth of 50%.



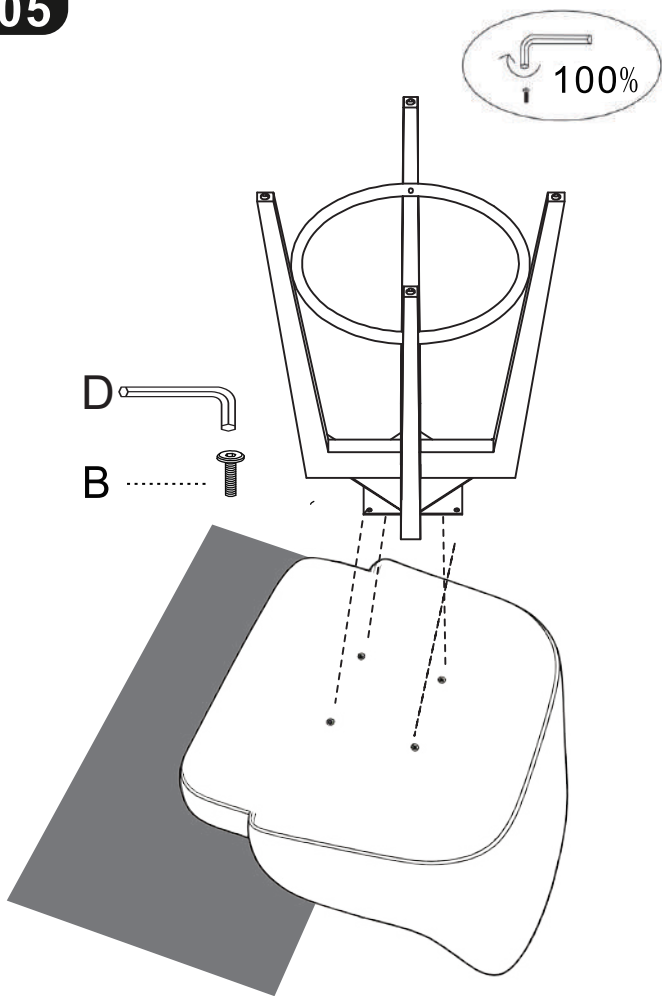

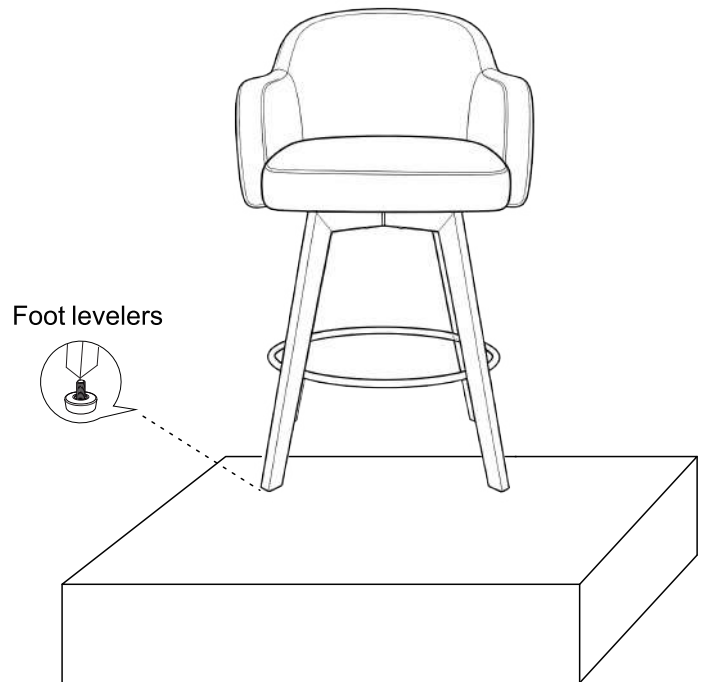
Swivel part (4) before install

Note:

Each leg has an adjustable foot leveler to help level your chair. Rotate it to ensure the chair is flat on the floor !

Additional Note About Safety

Bolts may loosen during normal everyday use. They should be periodically inspected and tightened to prevent damage or injury. Always check to be sure that all hardware is kept tightened.

Furniture Care & Maintenance

- Do not place hot items directly on the furniture surface.
- Do not clean the furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
- Do not place the furniture under direct sunlight.
- Do not place the furniture near heating or cooling vents.
- Do not write on the furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
- Do not place the furniture outside. For indoor use only.
- Stains may be removed with a mild soap solution and a damp cloth. Dust and pick up spills using a clean, non-colored lint-free cloth.
- Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
